A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to assent to an Alteration of the Royal Style Title. and Titles.

WHEREAS it is expedient that an alteration be Preamble. 5 made in the Royal Style and Titles, and that the assent

of the Parliament of New Zealand be given to that alteration:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the 10 authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Royal Titles Act, Short Title. 1947.

2. The assent of the Parliament of New Zealand is Assent of hereby given to the omission from the Royal Style and Parliament to alteration of 15 Titles of the words "Indiae Imperator" and the words Royal Style

"Emperor of India", and to the issue by His Majesty and Titles. for that purpose of His Royal Proclamation under the Independence Great Seal of the Realm.
