The provisions of sections three to six (inclusive) of "The Road Boards Act 1882 Amendment Act, 1888," shall apply to the said Board. 4. The said Board is hereby empowered to borrow money for the construction of waterworks. 5. The special order and other resolutions passed by the Board, and the votes of ratepayers taken upon the question of borrowing for the purpose of constructing waterworks, shall be as valid in all respects as if the same had been passed and taken after the passing of this Act.</p> | <p>Title.
