Title. 1. Short Title.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Slaughterhouses Act, 1877." BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :----

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Slaughterhouses Act short Title. 5 1877 Amendment Act, 1884;" and it shall be deemed to be incor-porated with, and shall be read with, "The Slaughterhouses Act, 1877," herein called "the said Act."

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in sections thirty-eight Road Boards and 10 to forty, both inclusive, of the said Act, the Road Boards and Town Town Boards in cases to have Boards of the road districts and town districts existing within coun- powers of inspecties wherein "The Counties Act, 1876," is not in operation, shall, fees, &c. within the limits of their respective jurisdictions, have all the powers granted by the said Act to County Councils in respect to the inspec-15 tion of slaughterhouses; and all fees and penalties accruing within

such jurisdictions under the said Act shall belong to such road districts or town districts, as the case may be, and shall be paid by the Magistrates receiving the same to the Boards thereof respectively.
