BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

| 10 | 2. In section two of "The Sheep Act, 1878," (herein referred to as "the said Act,") the word "eighty-two" shall be substituted for the word "eighty-one" where it occurs therein, and the said section shall henceforward be read accordingly. | Section 2 of "The Sheep Act, 1878," amended. |
| 15 | 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in section forty of the said Act, when two adjoining districts are both clean districts, the Governor may from time to time, by order published in the <i>Gazette</i> , declare that during the period therein mentioned sheep may be introduced by land from one such district to the other such district without giving to the Inspector the notice mentioned in the said section, and any such order may at any time be revoked. | When adjoining districts clean, Governor may authorize removal of sheep from one to the other without notice to Inspector. |
