A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Stamp Act, 1882."

Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Stamp Act Amendment
Act, 1905"; and it shall form part of and be read together with
"The Stamp Act, 1882" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal
Act").

Short Title.

10 2. No stamp duty shall be payable on any statutory declaration,
receipt, or other document made after the thirty-first day of August,
one thousand nine hundred and five, for the purposes of "The
Old-age Pensions Act, 1898."
