Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Stamp Act Amendment Short Title. Act, 1905"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Stamp Act, 1882" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act ").

2. No stamp duty shall be payable on any statutory declaration, purposes of old-age receipt, or other document made after the thirty-first day of August, one thousand nine hundred and five, for the purposes of "The from stamp duty. Old-age Pensions Act, 1898."
