A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the State Advances Act, 1913.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the State Advances Amendment  
Act, 1915, and shall be read with the State Advances Act, 1913  
(hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. Section thirty-one of the principal Act is hereby amended by  
10 adding thereto the following: "A statement of every such transfer  
shall within ten days thereafter be laid before both Houses of Parlia-  
ment if then in session, or if not, then within ten days after the  
commencement of the next ensuing session." Section 31 of  
principal Act  
amended.

3. Part I of the Fourth Schedule of the principal Act is hereby  
15 amended by striking out from the paragraph thereof headed  
"Secondly" the following words: "or other reputable insurance  
office to be from time to time approved by him." Fourth Schedule  
of principal Act  
amended.
