A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Stone-quarries Act, 1910.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Stone-quarries Amendment Act, 1911, and shall form part of and be read together with the Stone-quarries Act, 1910 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section nine of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows :—
- (a.) By omitting from subparagraph (v) of paragraph (a) the words " or used " :
- (b.) By omitting from subparagraph (viii) of paragraph (a) the words " three hours have," and substituting therefor the words " one hour has."
