A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Surveyors Act 1938

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Surveyors
Amendment Act 1960, and shall be read together with and
deemed part of the Surveyors Act 1938 (hereinafter referred
to as the principal Act).

10 2. **Membership of Institute**—Section 8 of the principal
Act is hereby amended by adding to subsection (1) the
following proviso:

15 “Provided that, if any surveyor satisfies the Council that
he has conscientious objection to membership of the Institute,
the Council may exempt that surveyor from membership.
Such exemption shall not affect that surveyor’s right to hold
an annual practising certificate, and the provisions of this
Act and of any rules made thereunder relating to the con-
duct or discipline of members of the Institute or regulating
20 charges shall apply to that surveyor as if he were a member
of the Institute.”
