A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Survey Act 1986

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

5 **1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Survey Amendment Act 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Survey Act 1986 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1988.

10 **2. Surveyor-General**—Section 7 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (2), and substituting the following subsections:

15 “(2) Subject to subsection (3) of this section, the office of Surveyor-General may be held in conjunction with the office of Director-General.

20 “(3) A Director-General who has at any time been appointed to the office of Director-General pursuant to a direction under section 35 (11) (a) of the State Sector Act 1988 may not at any time hold the office of Surveyor-General in conjunction with the office of Director-General.”
