A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Shops and Offices Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Shops and Offices Amendment Act, 1921, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shops and Offices Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. (1.) Section eleven of the Shops and Offices Amendment Act, 1920, and the Schedule to that Act are hereby repealed.

Repeals.

(2.) Section twelve of the last-mentioned Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "Sections two, nine, and eleven," and substituting the words "Sections two and nine."
