SHOPS AND OFFICES AMENDMENT BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 3 of this Bill extends to warehouses and goods stores the provisions of sections 50 to 53 of the Shops and Offices Act 1921-22. Those sections relate to sanitation and health rules in shops and offices.

Clause 4 enables regulations to be made to provide for the safety, health, and welfare of persons employed in shops, offices, warehouses, and stores, with particular reference to the matters which are already provided for by the Factories Act 1946 in relation to factories.

Clause 5 provides that where a shop assistant in a chemist's shop works between 7 and 9 p.m. on the statutory closing day, and is paid therefor at overtime rates prescribed by an award or industrial agreement, he is not to be also entitled to double time off within the next seven days.

(4) Every person who commits an offence against any regulation made under this section shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds, and, if the offence is a continuing one, to a further fine not exceeding five 5 pounds for each day on which the offence continues.

5. Section twenty-three of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:—
