

SHOPS AND OFFICES AMENDMENT BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THIS Bill amends section 6 of the Shops and Offices Act 1955 so that newspapers are added to the list of exempted goods set out in that section. Exempted goods may be sold in a shop at any time notwithstanding any provision in the Act or in any award requiring the shop to be closed.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Shops and Offices Act 1955

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
5 as follows:

- 1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Shops and Offices Amendment Act 1965, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shops and Offices Act 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 10 **2. Exempted goods**—Section 6 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in subsection (2), after paragraph (f), the following paragraph:
“(ff) Newspapers.”.
