A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Shops and Shop-assistants Act, 1894," and "The Shops and Shop-assistants Act Amendment Act, 1895." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Shops and Shop-assistants Acts Amendment Act, 1901." Short Title.

2. Subsection (a) of section seven and subsection (a) of section eight of "The Shops and Shop-assistants Act Amendment Act, 1895," are hereby repealed; and chemists' shops shall be included in the operation of section three of "The Shops and Shop-assistants Act, 1894." Chemists to have weekly half-holiday.

3. Subsections two and three of section four of "The Shops and Shop-assistants Act, 1894," are hereby re-enacted. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 4 of Act of 1894 re-enacted.

4. Section eight of "The Shops and Shop-assistants Act, 1894," is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "and all domestic servants" between the words "bars" and "within" in line three. Domestic servants to have weekly half-holiday.

5. "Domestic servants" as used in this Act means and includes all females engaged for hire to perform work of a manual character within a private house, refreshment-room, boardinghouse, eating-house, or restaurant. "Domestic servants" defined.

6. This Act shall be read and incorporated with "The Shops and Shop-assistants Act, 1894," and the various Acts amending the same. Act to be read together with prior Acts.
