1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Shipping and Seamen Short Title. Act Amendment Act, 1905"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Shipping and Seamen Act, 1903" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

2. The time within which application may be made under Time for application section twenty-seven of the principal Act for a service certificate is hereby extended to the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and five.

3. Subsection three of section one hundred and twelve of the section 112 of principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the words from and principal Act including "except in the case" to "exempt."

4. Section one hundred and twenty of the principal Act is Section 120 of hereby amended by inserting, after the word "apply" in subsection principal Act two, the words "to any intercolonial trading ship or."
