## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908. Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. (I) This Act may be cited as the Shipping and Seamen Short Title. Amendment Act, 1929, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the day on which His Commencement. Majesty's assent thereto is notified by the Governor-General by a Proclamation published in the Gazette, or on such later date (being not later than three months after the date of the publication of the Proclamation as aforesaid) as is specified in that behalf in the 15 Proclamation.
