### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Law relating to National Scholarships and Queen's Scholarships. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Scholarships Act, 1904." Short Title.
- 10 2. Section four of "The National Scholarships Act, 1903," is hereby amended by repealing the words "fourteen years of age" in paragraph (b), and substituting in lieu thereof the words "twelve years of age nor under eleven on the thirty-first day of December nearest to the date of the examination." Age of competitors for National Scholarships.
- 15 3. Section two of "The Queen's Scholarships Act, 1903," is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "fourteen years of age" in paragraph (a), the words "on the thirty-first day of December nearest to the date of the examination." Age of competitors for Queen's Scholarships.
4. A National Scholarship shall not be held by any one who is at the same time the holder of any other scholarship. National Scholarship not to be held with any other scholarship.
