A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Law relating to National Scholarships and Title. Queen's Scholarships.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Scholarships Act, Short Title. 1904."

2. Section four of "The National Scholarships Act, 1903," is Age of competitors 10 hereby amended by repealing the words "fourteen years of age" in paragraph (b), and substituting in lieu thereof the words "twelve years of age nor under eleven on the thirty-first day of December nearest to the date of the examination."

3. Section two of "The Queen's Scholarships Act, 1903," is Age of competitors 15 hereby amended by inserting, after the words "fourteen years of age" for Queen's in paragraph (a), the words "on the thirty-first day of December nearest to the date of the examination."

4. A National Scholarship shall not be held by any one who is National Scholarat the same time the holder of any other scholarship.
