A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Savings Bank Act, 1858," and "The Savings Bank Title. Profits Act, 1878."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament 5 assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Savings Bank Amendment Act, Short Title. 1882."
- 2. In relation to Savings Banks established under the provisions of "The Deposits how to be Savings Bank Act, 1858," the following provisions shall take effect from and received. 10 after the passing of this Act:
 - (1). Deposits of money may be received on behalf of the Trustees by the Manager and Accountant jointly:

If there is but one officer of the bank, then by such officer in the presence of a Trustee or some other person appointed by the Trustees for that purpose;

The presence of any Trustee at the time of receiving deposits shall not be necessary.

- (2). The Governor shall, from time to time, appoint fit and proper persons Governor to appoint to audit the accounts of any such Savings Bank, and may remove any Auditor so appointed.
- 3. The "Savings Bank Profits Act, 1878," is hereby amended as follows, Surplus funds may that is to say :-
 - (1). The definition of the word "Institution" in the second section of the said Act shall be read and construed as if the words "Public Library" had originally been inserted therein.
 - (2). Section fourteen of the said Act is hereby repealed.
