SUMNER BOROUGH FORESHORE VESTING AND EMPOWERING.

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A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest the Foreshore of Sumner Head in and to confer Title. certain Powers on the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Sumner.

5 WHEREAS it is expedient that the Sumner Borough Council Preamble. should be empowered to construct drainage-works for the drainage of the Borough of Sumner along the foreshore of Sumner Head and the adjacent bed of the sea, and from thence upon the bed of the sea, for the purpose of procuring an outfall for the drainage and sewage 10 of the borough and of discharging the said drainage and sewage into the sea, and to construct a road or street along the said foreshore and the adjacent bed of the sea, and, for the purposes of such drainage-works or of such road or street, to reclaim from the sea the existing foreshore and such portion of the bed of the sea below the existing 15 low-water mark as may be found necessary or convenient: And whereas it is expedient that for the purposes aforesaid the existing foreshore and part or parts of the adjacent bed of the sea should be vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Sumner:

20 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Sumner Borough Foreshore Short Title. Vesting and Empowering Act, 1912.

25 2. The foreshore of Sumner Head, as the same is more particularly defined in the Schedule to this Act, is hereby vested in and shall from and after the passing of this Act be held by the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Sumner, their successors and assigns, for an estate in fee-simple. 3. The Sumner Borough Council is hereby authorized and empowered to construct drainage-works for the drainage of the Borough of Sumner along the said foreshore as defined in the said Schedule or any part thereof and the adjacent bed of the sea below the existing low-water mark, and from thence upon the bed of the sea for the purpose of discharging drainage and sewage into the sea, and to construct a road or street along the said foreshore or any part thereof and the said adjacent bed of the sea. 5

4. The Governor may, by Order or Orders in Council, authorize the said Borough Council to reclaim from the sea the whole or any part or parts of the said foreshore and such part or parts of the adjacent bed of the sea, not exceeding five acres in all (including both foreshore and bed of the sea), as he shall consider necessary or convenient for the purposes of such drainage-works or of such road or street, and may, by the same or any other Order or Orders in Council, vest such part or parts of the bed of the sea so authorized to be reclaimed and also any other part of the bed of the sea upon which such drainage-works or road or street may be constructed or about to be constructed in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Sumner, their successors and assigns, for an estate in fee-simple. 10 15 20

SCHEDULE.

ALL the foreshore extending from the continuation of the south-eastern boundary of Rural Section 532 to the northern boundary of the area described (with other lands) in the Schedule to the Lyttelton Harbour Board Land Act, 1905, and therein referred to as delineated on the plan marked M.D. 2878(7), deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington: as the said foreshore is delineated on the plan marked M.D. , deposited in the Marine Department at Wellington, and therein coloured blue.
