A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest Part of the Foreshore within Sumner Estuary, opposite
Shag Rock, between Christchurch Tramway Causeway and the
Christchurch-Sumner Road, in the Corporation of the Borough of
Sumner. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows :—

2. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act within the meaning Deemed a special

described in the *Second* Schedule hereto shall vest in and be the property
of the Corporation of the Borough of Sumner as a reserve for the use,
recreation, and enjoyment of the inhabitants of the Borough of Sumner.

such public purpose or purposes for which the Sumner Borough Council

Sumner :

Provided that in respect of any work proposed to be constructed
in or upon the said lands below high-water mark of ordinary spring
tides the approval of the Governor-General in Council to such work
shall be obtained, in the manner provided by the Harbours Act, 1923,
before any such work is commenced.
