A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The State Coal-mines Act, 1901."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The State Coal-mines Act Amendment Act, 1904"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The State Coal-mines Act, 1901" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

Short Title.

2. (1.) The Governor may from time to time by Order in Council gazetted make regulations applying any of the provisions of any Act for the time being in force affecting or regulating the Civil Service to any of the persons or classes of persons appointed under subsection one of section six of the principal Act.

Persons appointed
under principal Act
not Civil servants.

(2.) Except as provided by any such regulations the provisions of any such Act shall not apply to persons appointed under the said subsection.
