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This PUBLIC BILL originated in the HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, and, having this day passed as now printed, is transmitted to the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL for its concurrence.

STATE-SCHOOL CHILDREN DRILL.

Title. ANALYSIS. 1. Short Title. 2. Compulsory to teach physical drill to boys 5. Children attending Native schools to be and girls attending public schools. taught physical drill. A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide that Education Boards shall cause Physical Drill Title. to be taught to Boys and Girls attending Public Schools.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The State-school Children Short Title. Drill Act, 1901," and it shall be read with and form part of "The Education Act, 1877."

- 2. It shall be the duty of the Board of Education in each district Compulsory to teach 10 constituted under "The Education Act, 1877," to cause physical physical drill to drill to be taught to all boys and girls over the age of eight years attending public attending the public schools in the school district.
- 3. The Education Board of each district shall from time to Education Board to 15 time, with the approval of the Governor in Council, make regula- make regulations. tions and orders for fixing the times which shall be appointed and set apart for instructing boys and girls of the required age in physical drill, and the mode in which such instruction shall be given; and the Education Board of each district may from time to
- 20 time, with the approval of the Governor in Council, alter or repeal **a**ny such regulations.

4. Every Education Board shall furnish a quarterly report to the Boards to furnish Minister of Education showing that the requirements of this Act and the regulations made thereunder are being complied with.

5. Out of the vote provided for Native schools the Minister of Children attending 25Education shall make provision for the teaching of physical drill Native schools to be taught physical children over the age of eight years attending Maori schools. drill.

6. Upon the principal teacher of any school being satisfied that Boys and girls may any boy or girl is unfit to undergo physical drill, such boy or girl be exempt from operation of Act. 30 shall be exempted from being instructed in such drill.

7. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of January, Date Act comes into one thousand nine hundred and two.
