## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to facilitate the Collection of Funds by School Title. Committees and Similar Bodies.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the

2. It shall be lawful for any School Committee, Minister of Home and School Association, or Parents' Association, Justice may issue permit to

Terms of permit may be varied.

4. The Minister of Justice may at any time withdraw any such permit, or vary, modify, or add to the terms and conditions thereof as to the Minister shall 10 seem fit.

5. The provisions of the Gaming Act, 1908, shall not apply to any game played in pursuance of such permit nor to the persons playing, taking part in, or conducting any game so played by reason only of their so doing, 15 nor to the premises wherein such game is played by reason only of the playing of such game therein.
