AN ACT to provide for the Permanent Appointment of an Addi- Title. tional Judge of the Supreme Court.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-5 lows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Supreme Court Judge Short Title. Appointment Act, 1900."

2. In lieu of the sum of seven thousand seven hundred pounds Appropriation for granted by "The Civil List Act, 1863," for defraying the expenses aslaries of Supreme Court Judges. of the salaries of the Judges of the Supreme Court, there is hereby substituted the sum of nine thousand two hundred pounds.
