2. Appropriation for salaries of Supreme Court 4. Repeal. A BILL INTITULED An Act to amend the Law relating to the Salaries of the Judges Title. of the Supreme Court. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:— 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Supreme Court Judges' Short Title. Salaries Act, 1904." 2. In lieu of the sum granted by "The Civil List Act, 1863," as Appropriation for 10 amended by "The Supreme Court Judge Appointment Act, 1900," salaries of Supreme Court Judges for defraying the expenses of the salaries of the Judges of the Supreme Court, there is hereby substituted the sum of eleven thousand pounds. 3. The said sum shall, without further appropriation than this Application of 15 Act, be applied in paying to the Judges of the said Court respectively appropriated. the annual salaries following, that is to say:— Annual salary of the Chief Justice £2,000 Annual salaries of five puisne Judges, each one thousand eight hundred pounds 9,000 20 Total £11,000
