## STATE-OWNED ENTERPRISES AMENDMENT BILL

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

THIS Bill amends the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986.

Clause 1 relates to the Short Title and commencement. The Bill is to come into force on 1 April 1988.

Clause 2 adds the Works and Development Corporation of New Zealand Limited to the State enterprises set out in the First Schedule to the principal Act.

Clause 3 adds the Works and Development Corporation of New Zealand Limited to the new State enterprises set out in the Second Schedule to the principal Act.

Clause 4 and the Schedule amend other Acts consequential upon the establishment of the Works and Development Corporation of New Zealand Limited as a State-owned enterprise.

## A BILL INTITULED

# An Act to amend the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the State-Owned Enterprises Amendment Act 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986\* (in this Act referred to as the principal Act).
  - (2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1988.
- 2. Addition to First Schedule—The First Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following item: "Works and Development Corporation of New Zealand Limited".
- 3. Addition to Second Schedule—The Second Schedule to15 the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following item:
  - "Works and Development Corporation of New Zealand Limited".
- 4. Consequential amendments—The enactments specified in the Schedule to this Act are hereby amended in the manner indicated in that Schedule.
