## A BILL INTITULED

An Act for the Protection and Preservation of Seals. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the second in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Seals Fisheries Pro-Short Title. 5 tection Act, 1878."

2. Section two of "The Protection of Animals Act Amendment Repeal.

Act, 1875," is hereby repealed.

3. No person shall hunt, catch, or attempt to catch or kill, seals close season for seals. between the days hereinafter mentioned (which interval is herein 10 referred to as "the close season"); that is to say between the first day of October and the first day of June following, both inclusive; and any person acting in contravention of this section shall forfeit any seal caught by him, and shall in addition thereto incur a penalty not exceeding fifty pounds, and a further penalty not exceeding ten 15 pounds in respect of each seal so caught.

4. The Governor may, by Order in Council, from time to time Close season may be extend or vary the time during which it is prohibited to hunt, varied. catch, or kill seals, and may from time to time vary the close season so extended, and may also prescribe that any such Order shall take 20 effect in the whole colony, or only in particular parts thereof to be

defined in such Order.

5. If he shall think it necessary for the preservation of seals to Fishery may be do so, the Governor may, in a similar manner, extend the time during closed. which it is prohibited to hunt, eatch, or kill seals over any term not 25 exceeding three years, and may at any time before the expiration of any such term further extend the same.

6. Any penalties imposed by this Act for the purpose of pro- Penalties to apply to hibiting the catching or killing of seals during the close season shall extended seasons. apply to such season however the same may be varied or extended.

7. The Governor may, by Order in Council, from time to time Districts may be exclude any part of the colony from the operation of this Act. excluded from Act.
