A BILL INTITULED

An Act to authorise the Construction of a Deviation of the Sentry Title. Hill to New Plymouth Railway.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Sentry Hill-New Short Title.

Plymouth Railway Deviation Act, 1905."

2. The Governor may from time to time, in the name and on Deviation of Sentry

3. The cost of constructing such deviation shall be paid out of How cost to be

moneys appropriated for that purpose by Parliament.

4. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act authorising the Act to be deemed a construction of the deviation of such railway to the extent specified special Act. in such Schedule, within the meaning and for the purpose of "The Public Works Act, 1894," and its amendments, which Acts are, so far as applicable, hereby incorporated with this Act.

5. The Minister for Railways may from time to time dispose of Power to sell land any part of the land on which the Sentry Hill to New Plymouth not required. Branch Railway now runs that is not required for the purposes of the railway, by public auction or public tender, in such manner and subject to such terms and conditions as he thinks fit.
