STEWART ISLAND COUNTY COUNCIL EMPOWERING.

ANALYSIS.

Title. 2. Foreshore vested in Conncil of Stewart Island Preamble. for so long as it acts as a Harbour Board. 1. Short Title.

A BILL INTITULED

- AN ACT to vest the Control of the Foreshore of the Sea in Half- Title. moon and Horseshoe Bays, in Stewart Island, in the County Council of Stewart Island, as exercising the Powers of a Harbour Board within the said Bays.
- WHEREAS by Order in Council, dated the thirty-first day of Preamble. August, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, and under authority of section two hundred and forty-two of "The Counties Act, 1886," the Governor did empower the Council of the County of
- 10 Stewart Island to exercise all the powers of a Harbour Board within the limits of the estuaries or arms of the sea, in the said Order in Council set forth, and which said estuaries or arms of the sea are called Half-moon Bay and Horseshoe Bay:
- And whereas the aforesaid Council has applied that the foreshore 15 of the sea in the above-mentioned bays may be vested in it, but section one hundred and forty-seven of "The Harbours Act, 1878," prohibits this being done, except under a special authority of the General Assembly in that behalf:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zea-**20** land in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Stewart Island County Short Title. Council Empowering Act, 1894." It shall be deemed to be a special Act within the meaning of section one hundred and forty-seven of 25 "The Harbours Act, 1878."

2. The foreshore of the sea in Half-moon Bay and in Horse-Foreshore vested in shoe Bay, in Stewart Island, within the limits set forth in the Order Council of Stewart Island for so long as in Council described in the recitals hereto, is hereby vested, under it acts as a Harbour "The Harbours Act, 1878," in the Council of the County of Stewart Board.

30 Island, as exercising the powers of a Harbour Board within the aforesaid limits, with all powers of a Harbour Board under such lastmentioned Act in respect to foreshores of the sea.

In case the aforesaid Council shall cease to exercise the powers of a Harbour Board as aforesaid, the foreshore of the bays hereby 35 vested in it shall cease to be so vested, and shall revest in Her Majesty, or vest in any Harbour Board or other authority which may succeed the Council in the exercise of the aforesaid powers.
