## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide that the Superintendents of certain Provinces shall, by virtue of their office, be Members of the Provincial Councils of the Provinces of which they are respectively Superintendents. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be the “Superintendents Short Title.  
5 *ex officio* Members of Provincial Council Act, 1872.”

2. The Legislatures of the Provinces of Auckland, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago may respectively, by Act or Ordinance, adopt this Act; and on an Act or Ordinance being passed by the Legislature of any of the said Provinces adopting this Act, thereupon the provisions of this Act hereinafter contained shall This Act may be adopted by Legisla-

3. In addition to the elected Members of the Provincial Council of any Province, the Legislature of which shall have adopted this Act, the Superintendent of such Province shall, by virtue of his office of Superintendent, and so long as he holds such office, be a Member of the Superintendents of
