## Sale of Food and Drugs Amendment.

### ANALYSIS.

### A BILL INTITULED

## AN ACT in Supplement of "The Sale of Food and Drugs Act, 1877."

**W**HEREAS it is necessary that fees should be appointed to be paid by offenders against the provisions of "The Sale of Food and Drugs Act, 1877" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), in respect of analyses conducted under the said Act:

**5** BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Sale of Food and Drugs Amendment Act, 1878," and it shall be deemed to be incorporated with the said Act, and be read therewith as one Act.

**2.** It shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time, by Order in Council, to appoint, alter, or revoke tables of fees to be paid in certain cases in respect of the analysis of any articles of food or drink by any Colonial Analyst appointed under the said Act. All which fees shall be paid, by the person receiving the same, into the Public Account.

**3.** When any person shall be convicted of any offence under the said Act, the convicting Magistrate or Justices shall order that all fees and other expenses incident to the analysis of any article of food or drink in respect of which the conviction is obtained shall be paid by the person convicted. All such fees and expenses shall be deemed to be part of the costs attending the conviction, and shall be recovered in the same manner as such costs are ordinarily recoverable.
