### A BILL INTITULED

#### An Act to amend the Sale of Liquor Act 1962

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 1978, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sale of Liquor Act 1962\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

10 **2. Circumstance to be taken into account (General Ancillary Licence)**—Section 112N of the principal Act (as inserted by section 26 of the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 1976) is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph after paragraph (c):

“(ca) The nature and extent of any use or uses to which the premises may have been put prior to the **hearing of such application**, for or associated with the principal activity of the applicant, including the provision or consumption of liquor, whether or not the same was made or done pursuant to a **licence or other formal authorisation.**” 5

**3. General ancillary licence (Principal Activity)**—(1) Section 65E (2) of the principal Act (as inserted by section 23 (1) of the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 1976) is hereby amended by repealing paragraphs (c) and (d), and substituting the following paragraphs: 10

“(c) Social recreation of persons having a common occupational, educational, technical, recreational, or cultural interest, whether or not every person present actively pursues that interest: 15

“(d) Social recreation of members of cultural, ethnic, national, or regional associations:”.

(2) The said section 65E (2) (as so inserted) is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraphs: 20

“(e) Social recreation of members of a sporting club or association, including members who are—

“(i) Participants in the sport;

“(ii) Officials of the club or association;

“(iii) Supporters of the club or association; or 25

“(iv) Associate, honorary, or life members of the club or association.”

(3) Section 65E (3) (b) of the principal Act (as so inserted) is hereby amended by omitting the words “incidental to”, and substituting the words “associated with”. 30
