SALE OF POISONS AMENDMENT.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Sale of Poisons Act, 1871."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Sale of Poisons Amendment Act, 1900."

Short Title.

2. The First Schedule to "The Sale of Poisons Act, 1871," is hereby amended by inserting at the end of each Part thereof the words: "Every compound containing any of the poisons mentioned in this Part of this Schedule, wherein the active principle of such poison is retained"; and, by repealing the words: "Every compound containing any of the poisons mentioned in this Schedule when prepared or sold for the destruction of vermin."
