A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Provisions of "The Savings Bank Profits Act, 1878." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Savings-banks Profits Act, 1906." Short Title.
2. Section fourteen of "The Savings Bank Profits Act, 1878," is hereby repealed. Repeal.
3. Section two of "The Savings-Bank Profits Act Amendment Act, 1902," is hereby amended by repealing the words "in Otago, so far as future profits are concerned." Section 2 of Amendment Act amended.
