### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to Amend the Supply Regulations Act, 1947. Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority

5 of the same, as follows:---

1. This Act may be cited as the Supply Regulations short Title. Amendment Act, 1948, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Supply Regulations Act, 1947 1947, No. 65-(hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. (1) The supply regulations specified in the First Revocation 10 Schedule to this Act are hereby revoked.

(2) The Schedule to the principal Act is hereby  $\frac{\text{supply}}{\text{regulations.}}$ amended by repealing so much thereof as relates to the regulations hereby revoked.

3. The supply regulations specified in the Second supply 15 Schedule to this Act, unless they are sooner revoked regulations. by the Governor-General in Council or by any Act, shall in force. continue in force until the thirty-first day of December. nineteen hundred and forty-nine, and shall then expire.
