STATE SERVICES AMENDMENT BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THIS Bill amends the Second and Third Schedules to the State Services Act 1962.

Both amendments are related to the establishment of a Ministry of Women's Affairs as a Department of the Public Service.

The amendment to the Second Schedule adds the name of the Ministry of Women's Affairs to the list of Departments of the Public Service set out in that Schedule.

The amendment to the Third Schedule adds the office of Secretary of Women's Affairs to the list of offices and positions exempt from appeal.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the State Services Act 1962

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the State Services Amendment Act 1984, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the State Services Act 1962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 2. Departments of the Public Service—The Second Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Valuation Department, the following item:

"Ministry of Women's Affairs".

3. Offices and positions exempt from appeal—The Third Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Valuation Department, the following item:

"Women's Affairs

Secretary".
