A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the State Services Act 1962

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the State Services Amendment Act 1984, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the State Services Act 1962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
