**A BILL INTITULED**

AN ACT to amend the Summer Time Act, 1929. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority  
5 of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Summer Time Amendment Act, 1933, and shall be read together with  
and deemed part of the Summer Time Act, 1929  
(hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

10 2. Subsection two of section two of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the word "March",  
and substituting the word "April". Section 2 of principal Act amended.

15 3. Subsection one of section three of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "thirty  
minutes", and substituting the words "one hour". Section 3 of principal Act amended.
