A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Summer Time Act. 1929. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority 5 of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Summer Time Short Title. Amendment Act, 1933, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Summer Time Act. 1929 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Subsection two of section two of the principal Section 2 of Act is hereby amended by omitting the word "March", principal Act amended. and substituting the word "April".

3. Subsection one of section three of the principal Section 3 of Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "thirty principal Act amended." minutes", and substituting the words "one hour".
