## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to fix the Time for General Purposes in New Title. Zealand.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Standard Time Act, Short Title 1945, and shall come into force on the first day of and January, nineteen hundred and forty-six.

2. For the purposes of this Act and of any other New Zealand Act the expression "New Zealand standard time" standard 10 means the time corresponding to the longitude of one hundred and eighty degrees east of Greenwich, being twelve hours in advance of Greenwich mean time.

3. (1) The time for general purposes in New Time for Zealand shall be New Zealand standard time as defined general purposes. by this Act.

(2) Wherever any reference to a point of time occurs in any enactment, Order in Council, order, regulation, rule, by-law, deed, notice, or other document whatsoever, the time referred to shall, unless it is otherwise specifically stated, be deemed to be New Zealand standard time as defined by this Act.

4. The Summer Time Act, 1929, and the Summer Time Amendment Act, 1933, are hereby repealed.
