### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Southland Waste Lands Act Amendment Act, 1873." Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Southland Waste Lands Act Amendment Act, 1873:" Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Southland Waste Lands Act 1873 Amendment Act, 1874." Short Title.

2. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent of Otago from time to time, by Proclamation in the Otago Provincial Government *Gazette*, to set aside and reserve from sale temporarily, and until the close of the Session then next ensuing of the Provincial Council, such blocks of land within the district formerly known as the Province of Southland as he shall see fit: Provided that such temporary reservation shall be null and void after the termination of the Session of the Provincial Council of Otago which shall be held next after the date of such Proclamation. Superintendent may make temporary reserves.
