A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to alter certain provisions of "The Timaru and Gladstone Board of Works Act 1867." Title.

WHEREAS by "The Timaru and Gladstone Board of Works Act 1867" it was provided that of the full amount to be realized by the sale of debentures to the amount of thirty thousand pounds sums not exceeding eight thousand pounds and three thousand pounds respectively might be expended in Timaru harbour works and a bridge over the Opiki River and the balance expended for the construction of a bridge over the Rangitata River And whereas it is expedient to make other provision in lieu thereof Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Timaru and Gladstone Board of Works Act 1867 Amendment Act 1869." Short Title.

2. Out of the balance of the amount realized by the sale of the above-mentioned debentures authorized by the Timaru and Gladstone Board of Works Act to be expended for the construction of a bridge over the Rangitata River it shall be lawful for the Timaru and Gladstone Board of Works to expend a sum not exceeding ten thousand pounds towards constructing a bridge over the Waitaki River Provided always that in no case shall any larger sum be expended on such bridge by the Timaru and Gladstone Board of Works out of the balance aforesaid than shall be contributed for the same work by the Provincial Government of Otago. Not exceeding £10,000 may be expended for a bridge over the Waitaki.
