A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Tourist and Publicity Department Act 1963

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Tourist and Publicity Department Amendment Act 1967, and shall be read together with and deemed part of 10 the Tourist and Publicity Department Act 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the fifteenth day of February, nineteen hundred and

sixty-seven.

2. Minister of Tourism—(1) Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (b) of the definition of the term "Minister" the words "Minister in Charge of Tourism", and substituting the words "Minister of Tourism".

(2) The principal Act is hereby further amended by omitting from section 11, and also from subsection (1) of section 13, the words "Minister in Charge of Tourism", and substituting in each case the words "Minister of Tourism".

(3) All other references to the Minister in Charge of 10 Tourism in any Act, regulation, rule, bylaw, order, or other enactment, or in any contract, agreement, deed, instrument, application, licence, notice, or other document whatsoever shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be read as references to the Minister of Tourism.

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
