## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to change the Purpose of a Recreation-ground at Te Title. Aroha, and to set apart other Lands for such Purpose.

WHEREAS the lands at Te Aroha, Piako County, in the Schedule Preamble.
5 hereto first described, were set apart for a recreation-ground, and have been brought under "The Public Domains Act, 1881," and the trustees thereof are desirous of acquiring in lieu thereof the unoccupied lands vested in Her Majesty in the Schedule hereto secondly described as being more convenient and accessible for the said pur10 pose :

And whereas the first-aforesaid lands are or could be made suitable for a racecourse, and the Te Aroha Jockey Club are desirous of obtaining the said lands for such purpose:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zea-15 land in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Te Aroha Recreation- Short Title. ground and Racecourse Act, 1892."

2. This Act shall be deemed a special Act within the meaning Act to be special 20 and for the purposes of "The Public Reserves Act, 1881" (herein Act.

referred to as "the said Act").

3. The lands first described in the Schedule hereto are hereby Land set apart for discharged from reservation as a recreation-ground, and are hereby racecourse at set apart as a racecourse reserve, and vested in William Herbert

25 Herries, Thomas Bradley, and Alexander Watson Edwards, all of Te Aroha, as trustees of the said racecourse, subject to the provisions of the said Act and "The Public Reserves Act 1881 Amendment Act, 1885."

4. The lands secondly described in the Schedule hereto are New recreation-30 hereby set apart and reserved as a recreation-ground under the said ground provided Act, and shall be deemed to be subject to "The Public Domains Act, 1881," and vested for the above purpose in the same persons as trustees thereof as the lands firstly herein described were vested at the time of the passing of this Act.

### TE AROHA RACECOURSE.

ALL that piece or parcel of land containing by admeasurement 121 acres, more or less, being northern portion of Section No. 5, Block XI., Te Aroha Survey District, Land District of Auckland. Bounded on the north by-township-reserve Section No. 89, Block IX., Te Aroha Survey District; on the north-east by a public road; on the south-east by the southern portion of Section No. 5; and on the west by Section No. 4. 107, a road, and Section No. 105 of the said Block XI.
