## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT for raising the sum of Fifty Thousand Title. Pounds  $(\pounds_{50,000})$  by Treasury Bills and to authorize the issue of Treasury Bills in the place of Treasury Bills issued under "The Treasury Bills Act 1866."

## MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN.

WE your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Representa- Preamble. tives of New Zealand in Parliament assembled towards raising the supplies which have been cheerfully granted to your Majesty in this Session of Parliament have resolved to grant unto your Majesty the 5 sum hereinafter mentioned

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Treasury Bills Act short Title. 10 1868."

2. Towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty Colonial Treasurer during the present Session it shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer authorized to make out Treasurer Bills from time to time to cause any number of Treasury Bills to be made to the amount of out at the Colonial Treasury for any sum or sums of money not fifty thousand pounds such Bills

of fifty thousand pounds (£50,000).
