1. Short Title.

Treasury Bills under Acts of 1868 and 1869 may be reissued till 1st November, 1874.

A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to extend the Currency of Treasury Bills issued under "The Treasury Bills Act, 1869."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Treasury Bills Short Title.

Extended Currency Act, 1870."

2. Whenever payment of the principal moneys of any of the Treasury Bills under Treasury Bills issued under the authority of "The Treasury Bills Act, Acts of 1868 and 1869 may be reissued till 1868," or "The Treasury Bills Act, 1869," shall be claimed or be 1st November, 1874. payable to any holder thereof, the Colonial Treasurer may order the preparation and issue of a like amount of Treasury Bills in the place of such Treasury Bills, and all Bills made out under the authority of this Act shall be prepared made out and issued in the manner prescribed by "The Treasury Bills Regulation Act, 1868," and any Act amending the same, and may bear interest at any rate not exceeding fourpence for every one hundred pounds by the day in respect of the whole moneys contained therein, and such Bills may be renewed and reissued from time to time: Provided always that the currency of such Bills shall in no case be made to extend beyond the first day of November, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four.
