# Taranaki Cemetery Reserves.

## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to appropriate a Portion of certain Educational Title. Reserves in the Provincial District of Taranaki as Cemeteries.

THEREAS the parcels of land respectively described in the Preamble. Schedule hereto, forming severally a portion of an educational reserve, are needed for the purposes of a cemetery at Manutahi North, Okato, Oakura, and Urenui respectively, all the aforesaid places being 5 within the Provincial District of Taranaki, and it is fitting that the said lands, comprising an area each of about five acres, more or less, should be reserved for the purposes of a cemetery at the above-named

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 10 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Taranaki Cemetery Short Title. Reserves Act, 1879."

2. The lands described in the Schedule hereto shall, from and Lands in Schedule 15 after the passing of this Act, cease to be respectively part of an to cease to be reserved for educaeducational reserve, and the School Commissioners in whom the same tional purposes. are respectively at present vested shall, from the aforesaid date, be devested thereof, and the same shall be deemed to be Crown lands.

3. The said lands are hereby appropriated for the purposes of a Lands appropriated 20 cemetery at Manutahi North, Okato, Oakura, and Urenui respectively, for cometeries. all within the aforesaid Provincial District of Taranaki, and shall be administered under the provisions of "The Cemeteries Management Act, 1877," and may be vested in such trustees as the Governor may appoint for the aforesaid purposes.

#### MANUTAHI TOWNSHIP (NORTH).

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Taranaki, containing by admeasurement one (1) acre, more or less, being Sections numbered two (2) and three (3) on the map of Manutahi Township (North), Paritutu Survey District. Bounded towards the North by Barton Street, three hundred and thirty-four (334) links; towards the East by Section numbered four (4), three hundred (300) links; towards the South by Cross Street, three hundred and thirty-four (334) links; and towards the West by Section numbered one (1), three hundred (300) links.

#### OKATO.

All that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Taranaki, containing by admeasurement two (2) acres, more or less, being part of Town Belt numbered two (2) on the map of the Okato Township, Cape Survey District. Bounded towards the Northwest by a school site, three hundred and thirty-five (335) links, and the South Road ninety-two (92) links; towards the North-east by other part of said Allotment No. 2, seven hundred and five (705) links; towards the South-east by Town Belt numbered four (4), four hundred and twenty-seven (427) links; and towards the South-west by Town Sections sixty-four (64), sixty-eight (68), and seventy-two (72), four hundred and five (405) links.

All that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Taranaki, containing by admeasurement two (2) acres, more or less, being part of Town Belt numbered eight (8) on the map of the Oakura Township, Cape Survey District. Bounded towards the North and East by Town Belt numbered nine (9), three hundred and fifty (350) links, and by the Oakura River; towards the South and East by other part of said Allotment No. 8, six hundred and seventy (670) links; and towards the South-west, West, and North-west by Hussey Street eight hundred and eighty (880) links.

### URENUI TOWNSHIP.

All that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Taranaki, containing by admeasurement three (3) acres two (2) roods, more or less, being part of Town Belt numbered three (3) on the map of the Urenui Township, Waitara Survey District. Bounded towards the North by Nikorima Street and part of No. 2 Town Belt, six hundred and ninety (690) links; towards the East by the Haoko Stream; towards the South by other part of No. 3, four hundred and forty (440) links; and towards the West by the Urenui Township and a road, six hundred and five (605) links.
