### A BILL INTITLED

AN ACT to remove certain Restrictions on the Constitution of  
Town Districts in certain Counties. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Town Districts Act,  
1906." Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding any Act wherein it is provided that no local  
10 body or authority other than the County Council shall, within the  
limit of any county, be created or exercise any jurisdiction or  
authority over any roads or over or in relation to any matter or  
thing in respect of which jurisdiction is conferred upon a County  
Council under the principal Act, it is hereby declared that such  
15 provision shall not prevent the constitution of any town district  
by the Governor under the authority of "The Town Districts Act,  
1904." Power to constitute  
town districts in  
certain counties.
