- AN ACT to provide for Clerks and Others who were temporarily Title. employed in the Public Service on the coming into Force of the Public Service Act, 1912.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Temporary Employees Act, short Title. 1913.

- 10 2. Temporary employment under this Act and under the Public Interpretation of rice Act, 1912, shall not include— (a.) Employment of persons specially engaged for summer or restricted. Service Act, 1912, shall not include
 - other seasonal work:
 - (b.) Employment of persons casually engaged at an hourly rate of pay or at daily rates for less than one month.

3. The Public Service Commissioner may continue to employ in Extension of service the Public Service for such period as he may consider necessary of temporary employees. persons temporarily employed in the Public Service on the coming into force of the Public Service Act, 1912, and whose employment

- 20 has been since continued under section forty-five of that Act. 4. The Commissioner shall, subject to the approval of the Regulations Governor in Council, make regulations determining the conditions providing for of employment of such persons and prescribing conditions under Public Service of which they may be appointed to the Public Service, and providing temporary employees.
- 25 that persons appointed by virtue of any such regulations shall not in any case obtain precedence over public officers appointed before them.
